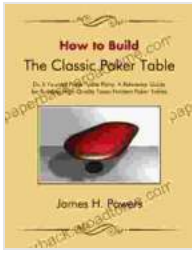

### Materials and Tools

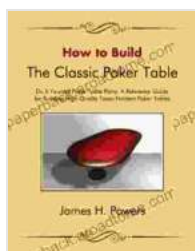
