- Worsted weight yarn in brown, white, and red
- 3.5mm crochet hook
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Stuffing material (polyester fiberfill or cotton balls)
- Safety eyes (optional)
- Buttons or beads for antlers (optional)
- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. **Round 1:** Crochet 6 single crochet stitches (sc) into the magic ring. Close the round with a slip stitch (sl st).
- 3. **Round 2:** Increase in every stitch around. (2 sc in each st) You should have 12 stitches.
- 4. Round 3:1 sc, increase Repeat around. (18 stitches)
- 5. **Rounds 4-16:** Continue crocheting in the round without increasing. (18 stitches per round)
- 6. **Round 17:** Decrease in every stitch around. (2 sc tog) You should have 9 stitches.
- 7. **Round 18:**1 sc, decrease Repeat around. (6 stitches)

- 8. **Round 19:** Slip stitch to close the hole.
- 1. Make a magic ring.
- 2. **Round 1:** Crochet 6 single crochet stitches (sc) into the magic ring. Close the round with a slip stitch (sl st).
- 3. **Round 2:** Increase in every stitch around. (2 sc in each st) You should have 12 stitches.
- 4. **Round 3:**1 sc, increase Repeat around. (18 stitches)
- 5. **Rounds 4-10:** Continue crocheting in the round without increasing. (18 stitches per round)
- 6. **Round 11:** Decrease in every stitch around. (2 sc tog) You should have 9 stitches.
- 7. **Round 12:** 1 sc, decrease Repeat around. (6 stitches)
- 8. **Round 13:** Slip stitch to close the hole.
- Round 1: Crochet 6 single crochet stitches (sc) into a magic ring.
 Close the round with a slip stitch (sl st).
- 2. **Round 2:** Increase in every stitch around. (2 sc in each st) You should have 12 stitches.
- 3. **Round 3:**1 *sc, increase* Repeat around. (18 stitches)
- 4. Round 4:2 sc, increase Repeat around. (24 stitches)
- 5. **Round 5:** Continue crocheting in the round without increasing. (24 stitches per round)

- 6. **Round 6:** Decrease in every stitch around. (2 sc tog) You should have 12 stitches.
- 7. **Round 7:**1 *sc, decrease* Repeat around. (6 stitches)
- 8. Round 8: Slip stitch to close the hole.
- Round 1: Crochet 6 single crochet stitches (sc) into a magic ring.
 Close the round with a slip stitch (sl st).
- 2. **Round 2:** Increase in every stitch around. (2 sc in each st) You should have 12 stitches.
- 3. **Round 3:**1 *sc, increase* Repeat around. (18 stitches)
